

ALCOHOL AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE POLICY

Be it known that Phi Chi Theta does not condone nor authorize the advertising, serving and/or consumption of alcohol or illegal substances at any Phi Chi Theta function.

Disciplinary measures will be taken against any chapter that:

- 1) Uses chapter funds to purchase alcohol or illegal substances;
- 2) Allows the use of alcohol or illegal substances at any Phi Chi Theta ceremony;
- 3) Allows minors to consume and/or use alcohol or illegal substances at any Phi Chi Theta activity and/or
- 4) Violates and Federal, State, Local and/or University laws and/or regulations.

Disciplinary actions will be decided by the Executive Policy Board.

HAZING RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: We find hazing to be a detestable tradition which overshadows the positive and constructive accomplishments of this fraternity and,

WHEREAS: Phi Chi Theta should strive to create an atmosphere where people are not ruled by intimidation and degradation and,

WHEREAS: We find this to be a non-productive activity and,

WHEREAS: Hazing is condemned by all colleges and universities, as well as being against many state laws,

THEREFORE: **BE IT RESOLVED** that in order to advance the best interests of the fraternity, Phi Chi Theta prohibits hazing by any chapter or members thereof.
