

Anna E. Hall

Memorial Scholarship

- ❑ Scholarship was established in 1989 to honor the late memory of Anna E. Hall, Founder (Colorado Alpha Chapter – Univ. of Denver)
- ❑ National President of Phi Theta Kappa business sorority (1924)
- ❑ Facilitated the pre-merger negotiations in Pittsburgh between Phi Theta Kappa and Phi Kappa Epsilon
- ❑ Led the Phi Theta Kappa convention in 1924 that resulted in the merger and creation of Phi Chi Theta
- ❑ Active member of the Chicago Alumni Chapter
- ❑ In 2007, **Andrew Noh** – *Zeta Beta – University of Michigan* was the recipient of the Anna E. Hall scholarship



Helen D. Snow Memorial Scholarship

- ❑ Scholarship was established to honor the late memory of Helen Snow, Honorary Member (Delta Chapter – Northwestern Univ.)
- ❑ Served as Dean of the Evening Division, School of Business, Northwestern University
- ❑ Advisor to the Delta Chapter – Northwestern University
- ❑ She served as a mentor to members who were "minority" (female students on a basically male-dominated campus at Northwestern)
- ❑ Restricted contributions made through the Foundation by members, friends, and corporations to the scholarship fund are tax deductible
- ❑ In 2007, **Amy McMahon** – *Zeta Beta* – *University of Michigan* was the recipient of the Helen D. Snow Scholarship
